Object Lesson

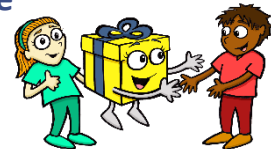
Adult note Ask your student to explain the object lesson.

AIMM™ Goals

Adult note Decide on goals to strengthen Compassion.

At school: Be kind to classmates. Go out of your way to say hello. Sit with someone that's alone.
At home: Tell family members that you love them. Help with someone else's chores.

Lifestory Summary

Adult note Ask your student to summarize the story.



Mikey Carraway was living a normal life. Then at age 11 he got very sick and needed a new liver or he would die. After receiving a new liver, Mikey had a deep compassion to help others and wanted to give to others for the gift he had been given. He has done that by feeding over 4,000 homeless people and by helping sign up organ donors.
