Theme

Adult note Ask your child to state the theme.

Object Lesson

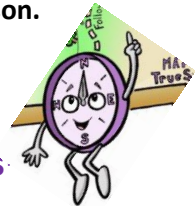
Adult note Ask your child to explain the object lesson.

AIMM™ Goals

Adult note Decide on goals to strengthen Integrity.

At school: Do my own schoolwork and try my best. Follow the rules.

At home: Keep my promises. Tell the truth, no matter what the consequences.

Lifestory Summary

Adult note Ask your child to summarize the story.



Imagine you are seven years old, have two sisters and are living in a depressing orphanage in Guatemala. A couple from another country promise to adopt all three of you and bring you to live with them. Would you still believe their promise after three years of waiting? This is the lifestory of the Aromis.
