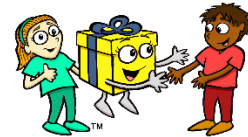
Ask your student to explain the object lesson.

AIMM™ Goals

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Decide on goals to strengthen Compassion.

At school: Be kind to classmates. Go out of your way to say hello. Sit with someone that's alone.

At home: Tell family members that you love them. Help with someone else's chores.

Lifestory Summary

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Ask your student to summarize the story.
